

**ORDINANCE NO. 413.1**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF  
KINGS AMENDING SECTION 2-2.1 OF THE KINGS COUNTY CODE OF  
ORDINANCES**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Kings, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE KINGS COUNTY  
CODE OF ODINANCES.

Article I of Chapter 2 Section 2-2.1 of the Kings County Code of Ordinances is hereby  
amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2.1 – Clerk of the board of supervisors declared appointive office.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the board of supervisors by virtue of section 25100.5  
of the Government Code of the state, the office of clerk of the board of supervisors is  
declared to be an appointive office to be filled by appointment by the County Executive  
Officer.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after  
its adoption and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage; it (or a summary) shall  
be published with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against  
the same in the Hanford Sentinel newspaper published in the County of Kings.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and properly introduced at a regular meeting of the  
Board of Supervisors held on September 30, 2025, and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board  
of Supervisors of the County of Kings held on October 7, 2025, by the following vote:
