

ORDINANCE NO. 719

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF KINGS
ADDING SECTION 2-9 TO THE KINGS COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES
PERTAINING TO ADMINISTRATION**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Kings, State of California, ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Government Code sections 84615 and 87500.2 permit local government agencies to require online filing of specified statements, reports, or other documents; and

WHEREAS, the County Registrar of Voters has proposed adoption of an online filing system for specified campaign disclosure documents; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the proposed online filing system will operate securely and effectively and will not unduly burden filers.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Kings, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: ADDING OF SECTION 2-9 IN CHAPTER 2 ARTICLE I OF THE KINGS COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

Chapter 2 Article I of the Kings County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding Section 2-9 to read as follows:

“Section 2-9 - Electronic Filing of Campaign and Other Disclosure Statements.

A. Any elected officer, candidate, committee, or other person required by Chapters 4 or 7 of the Political Reform Act (California Government Code sections 84100, et seq.) to file statements, reports or other documents with the County Registrar of Voters may file such statements, reports, or documents using the County Registrar of Voters online system according to procedures established by the County Registrar of Voters. The requirement for online filing shall be subject to the exemptions, limitations, and

requirements set by California Government Code sections 84615 and 87500.2 and applicable regulations adopted by the California Fair Political Practices Commission.

B. All material filed electronically pursuant to this section shall be made available to the public free of charge. However, the data made available on the internet shall not contain the street name and building number of the persons or entity representatives listed on the electronically filed forms, nor any bank account number required to be disclosed by the filer. The County Registrar of Voters shall make a complete, unredacted copy of such filed materials, including any street names, building numbers, and bank account numbers disclosed by the filer, available to any person upon request.”

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE.


This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage; it (or a summary) shall be published with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same in the Hanford Sentinel newspaper published in the County of Kings.
